New York State Conference Membership

The most recent membership information was obtained from Katherine Isaac of the AAUP National Office on March 27, 2009. The figures show that the New York State Conference currently has 4,966 members, which represents a very slight increase (0.63 percent) from 4,935 members in Fall 2008. There are a total of 136 institutions in New York State which have AAUP members and there are 52 chapters that have a membership of seven or more. Currently, eleven of the chapters are collective bargaining chapters with a total of 3,532 members, which represents a decrease of less than a half of one percent (0.45) from 3,548 members that were reported by the National Office last fall.
